### Fly burying ground - windscreen

#### Tips and tools from Rameder for gentle removal of insects on the car

The engine is purring, the sun is shining, and the air-conditioning system in the car ensures cooling on hot days. Outings in summer could be so nice... if there were no insects. For example, it has proved that moistening a lady's stocking helps to remove the insect spots by carefully rubbing. The finely woven fabric does not harm the paint, but removes the squashed insects. The alternative: Wetten an old bed sheet, and lay it on the surface concerned for twenty minutes. After soaking, use a clean rag to wipe off - that's it.

Another insider tip: When the small hexapods stick to the number plate, shaving foam will help. Simply spray on, and after ten minutes the insects can be wiped off.

It is easiest, however, to remove the unwanted road users with a special insect remover for the car. Without a lot of scratching and scrubbing, even the most stubborn dirt can be removed again - effectively and gently on all surfaces, also on paint and plastic.

Simply spray the insect remover on the dirty spot on the vehicle, permit to soak and wipe off. And, the insect accident is a matter of the past, and the car is nice to look at again.
